

Why pets find themselves at WCAC

Keep Animals Safe

Keeping animals safe is really important

- For example there are a lot of foods that can harm our pets if eaten, like toothpaste, gum, and chocolate.

- You should microchip your pet so if your pet somehow gets lost and someone finds it a veterinarian can scan to see your information, like your phone number and where you live.

Keep animals healthy


Give them food, love, and shelter
